and talents with the parish in this way greatly enhances the beauty of prayer together in church. May your willingness to do so inspire other to do the same.

The Easter Vigil last weekend was a very special evening as it always is. The evening is unmistakably spiritual and beautiful. 

#### PARENT EDUCATIONAL FREEDOM ACT

(419) 524-2572 x2125

Senate Bill 11, called the "Parent Educational Freedom Act," will expand eligibility for Educational Choice scholarships (ÉdChoice) to all students in Ohio beginning with the 2023-2024 school year. It would provide to parents for each pupil up to \$5,500 for grades K-8, and \$7,500 for grades 9-12. It also increases the amount of homeschooling expenses that a taxpayer can claim as an income tax credit each year, from \$250 to \$2,000. 
